Ces deux fleuves, par les méandres de leurs cours, rompent agréablement l'uniformité du terrain aride, sec, sablonneux, où croissent seulement des buissons épineux, et dispensent la vie à la végétation non interrompue qui court le long de ses rives. Ils s'enroulent autour d'une vallée fertile ombragée de saules et tracent deux profonds sillons au milieu d'une terre presque unie. Le Rio-Négre coule dans une vallée cernée par de hautes falaises coupées à pic, que les eaux viennent battre encore. Là où elles se sont retirées, elles ont laissé des terrains d'alluvion revêtus d'une végétation éternelle, et ont formé des îles nombreuses peuplées de saules et contrastant avec l'aspect triste des falaises nues des coteaux. Les singes, les grisons, la mouffette, le renard, le loup rouge parcourent incessamment et dans tous les sens les déserts de la Patagonie, en concurrence avec le cougar, lion d'Amérique, et les imbaracayas, ces chats sauvages si féroces et si redoutables.
